



# BestialityUganda's latest weapon in its battle to eliminate homosexuality

Edwin Sesange, gay rights activist, gives the whole picture of what is going on with Uganda's new anti-gay bill...

he Anti-Homosexuality Act is dead. Out of the ashes comes the Prohibition of Promotion of Unnatural Sexual Practices Bill If this is passed, it will be one of the most evil and draconian anti-LGBTI laws in the world.

It seems lawmakers have learned their lessons when it came to drafting a bill, forcing us to jump a lot more hurdles.

In the preamble of the leaked bill, unnatural sexual practices are defined as 'a sexual act between a person of the same sex, or with or between a transsexual person, a sexual act with an animal, and anal sex within the meaning of section 145 of the penal code act.'

In this definition homosexuality is in the same category with bestiality. This exact wording is not accidental but it has been well thought through. It is well known that most people against homosexuality always scapegoat gay people for the diseases that are somehow related to

In the African culture, a person who has sex with an animal is deemed insane, an outcast, demonic, unnatural and they face the most severe punishment that is often death. Such a practice is believed to bring a wrath from God and the goddess of the land and therefore it is upon the community to excommunicate such people from the society.

Using the term, 'prohibition of unnatural sexual practices', it is aimed at bringing on board even those who were becoming liberal towards homosexuality. Are you against this bill? Well then do you support having sex with animals?

By forcing us to oppose this bill with people who have sex with animals, it will only create more hatred towards LGBTI people and their allies in Uganda.

The bill goes further to specify a person 'shall not promote or aid or abet the promotion of the performance of

unnatural sexual practices'. This means any involvement in any advertising, publishing, use of the internet, mobile phones, dating websites, transports, or leasing a property for the purposes of engaging in unnatural sexual practices leads to imprisonment for seven

Are you a taxi driver unknowingly transporting an LGBTI person in your car? Jail. Are you their landlord? Jail.

The timing of this is not insignificant. In early 2016, Uganda will be voting for

its president. If Museveni succeeds, he will have spent 30 years in power.

Most of his challengers are aware the current surveys indicate 96% of Ugandans oppose homosexuality, so they are of course going to support this bill.

So while Museveni appears to be faltering over a reintroduction of a new antigay law, possibly concerned over Uganda's standing

on the world stage, this will likely not last for long.

But what can we do?

Instead of fighting against the entire bill, we could appeal to government to delete the words 'same-sex' and 'same-sex marriage' from the document. If we do,

we would support a bill banning the promotion of bestiality.

We should appeal to the courts, urge them to deliberate on the constitutionality of the bill.

We need to empower LGBTI people, both in Uganda and around the world, to fight against it. Work with international companies in order to implement global equality standards inclusive of gay, bi, lesbian, trans and intersex people.

We have won one battle, but we haven't won the war.

They want to scapegoat the LGBTI community, force us to disappear. But we will not as we will work. They want to make an example of us, so let's deny them the opportunity.

# How to build a Queer Nation

Promoter **Patrick Lilley** talks about the biggest influences that created **Queer Nation**, one of London's longest running regular club nights that celebrates its 24th birthday this weekend...



#### Queer Nation was influenced by Queer

Nation... a direct action group in the USA 1990. When on holiday in San Francisco I nicked their flyer. A friend called Space drew placards and filled it with the DJs names and prices on. I attended a QN group meeting in LA. They asked me what I did. I mumbled Queer Nation London. An arch queen followed me out and said, "I know about

you. My friend Jerry Mills comic artist drew the art you used!" I nearly died. "And he is seriously ill and he has seen what you have done." I just waited for the ground to open up and swallow me. "He just LOVES what you have done with it!"



What are the Queer Nation musical influences? The resident DJs chose the sounds not me. Luke Howard and Princess Julia at the Gardening Club in 1990–97. Supadon, Franceso and Jeffrey Hinton at Substation and since then Supadon and Mista Pierre. QN, unlike most gay UK clubs except Horse Meat Disco, books top US DJs like Frankie Knucles, Francois Kervorkian, Masters at Work all of whom personally asked to play for us.

#### New York's Paradise Garage (1977-87)

paved the way for Queer Nation, which opened in 1990, in terms of uptempo soul music. I went to the Garage in '86 and I couldn't persuade anyone to go with me, it was not so hip then. It was an amazing, but I didn't consciously set out to recreate a "garage" night. I'd already done one with Norman Jay called High on Hope and had Chaka and Loleatta played for me. It just happened. I am actually co-hosting a HIV charity fundraiser night called A Night In Paradise (at the Ministry of Sound, Sunday 30th November) with Adam Newsome, Horse Meat Disco and Handsome and bevvy of top American DJs include Danny Krevit, David Depino and more for Gay Mens Health Crisis and THT. I met the 'Garage owner at the Queer Nation event in Paris in early 90s when I was drunk. I literally got on my knees and kissed his feet. We became friends and he came to the club often staying to the end of the night dancing 'til into his seventies! He'd bring four t-shirts to change into over the night. He died six years ago in January 2008, aged 73 having caught HIV in his seventies.




How do you choose the venues? Venus chose us. We started on a Sunday with 65 people at the Gardening Club in 1990. It has enjoyed some great residencies especially The Joiners Arms, Substation South, Crash/Union and Barcode. Heaven 's David Inches said to me. "DJs are ten a penny but good staff are hard to find." I'd amend that and say, "A great doorman is worth 10 DJs." I give special props to 'Big Daddy' Leroy King who is the first person you will meet at you arrive at Barcode on Saturday night for our 24th Birthday.

The most frequently asked question: "Is Queer Nation a black club?" Queer Nation is about sound not colour. All are welcome. I have won awards for being 'Best Black & Ethnic Minority' club and I never declined it! But it's a bit like being called gay if you are bi? What do you do? Sue them? We are an all-nations club. Studio 54 DJ Kenny Carpenter summed it up when asked about Queer Nation's longevity, he said, "I think QN parties have endured so long mainly because of the people and the music. The second reason may be the name itself. It's always had a warm welcoming feeling about it."

# Welcome to KAOS...

Queer artists, performers and leftfield misfits in London all have one underground community in common: **KAOS**.



was created as an alternative to the mainstream gay scenes, an expansive and inclusive enclave that embraced individualism, eccentricity, cultural anarchy, experimentation and creativity,' says the night's creator Lee Adams. If you thought the underground queer scene of experimentation and creativity had been consumed by the new Tory world order of equal marriage, you've never been to KAOS.

The off-shoot community coils and writhes alive beneath the surface of

mainstream gay community in London; a glittering serpent hissing of otherness when glimpsed from the outside. But inside, it's a home for the many in London who have abodes but not homes; a family for the familyless; a place for foreigners and outsiders, for the queer. For eleven years, all have been welcomed into its belly.

the modern.

'One reason

why the parties are so fascinating is because of this crossover in terms of age, class, gender, sexuality,' continues Lee. 'It's very rare to find such a diverse spectrum of people in one social space. I think what unites all these disparate entities

is their lack of a sense of belonging. The other thing that unites the crowd is an intense passion for music and the cathartic communion of the dancefloor.'

KAOS began at Madame Jojo's on Sunday afternoons, with Jay Cloth on the door in a long ash-blond wig, looped across his top lip to form a moustache, wearing a high Victorian lace collar and white contact lenses. 'The crowd was elaborately dressed up and the music fierce from the start,'

says Lee. From its Soho beginnings, it travelled through Hackney, Spitalfields, and the 'golden days' of transgendered club Stunners, until its current incarnation at Electrowerkz in Islington.

Adams trained as a sculptor and 'spent a decade making immersive installations, experimental films and collaborating on large-scale outdoor theatre events with pyro-technicians, performers,

musicians', explaining some of the emphasis on spectacle at KAOS. He met Bradley KAOS in Thailand 1999, and they discussed making a queer techno club. From a swirling of thoughts, KAOS was born.

'It's not just gay men, but also dykes,

Right from the start it was born out of a creative current. Most of our friends are artists designers musicians performers

transmen, transwomen, and straight people,' Lee comments. 'I think KAOS has been so influential as an incubator of creativity because right from the start it was born out of a creative current. Most of our friends are artists, designers, musicians, performers, filmmakers... KAOS precipitated so much crosspollination, it brings all these creatively engaged people together and then magic starts to happen.'

KAOS is a zeitgeist for queer fertility and self-expression. It stands at the precipice of wider knowledge. It's a chameleon, adapting and evolving through venues. But it is still the spirit of inclusion that roots at this brooding alternative community's heart.

'The crowd is still very diverse,' he concludes. 'Many of the people who are working in music, fashion, art and the club scene – performers, DJs, musicians – come to party with us, from twenty-somethings, to fifty-somethings. KAOS is a multiplicity, a multiverse of characters.'

# IT'S NOW AS MUCH of a

modern festive tradition (on the scene anyway) as those red cups from that semen-laden coffee joint, or that heart-wrenching TV commercial with the whimsical storyline and endearing animals (which is supposed to make us dash out and buy their homeware). Now in it's eighth year, the RVT panto returns with a very

modern twist on the story of Jack and The Beanstalk, written by Gareth Joyner.

The cast of five may seem small by panto standards, however this show is a perfect example of quality over quantity. They all excel in their respective roles and compliment each other beautifully, meaning there's never a dull moment, even when Myra DuBois

fluffs her lines. In fact, those are the parts we all secretly love, aren't they? You can tell she does.

Harry Clayton-Wright (pictured) who plays the famehungry, social media mad Jack resembles a scantily-clad Zebedee on speed. "Who needs friends when you have LIKES." A cheeky chappie, who is not afraid to display that cheek (you've been warned). His boundless energy and enthusiasm juxtaposes Dame Trott's (Myra) calmness and disdain for the world around her, just as it should, and their onstage chemistry shines throughout.

The storyline is, as you'd expect, peppered with plenty of the traditional panto fayre, as well as lashings of filth and innuendo. (Who doesn't love innuendo? I personally couldn't go a day without it.) For the more discerning panto-goer there's an added injection of celebrity scandal, dogging and gender stereotyping. The latter is displayed simply, but is so clever in its simplicity - the highlight of the show.

As well as slick dialogue and high quality costumes, the music chosen for the show will appeal to most: country, musical theatre, traditional and rock kept the audience fully engaged. There's even a saxophone solo. The finale, especially for me as a super fan of this particular group, was SPOT ON!

Jack! Sissy That Stalk gets the balance of traditional, adult and socio-cultural just right. A must see panto this consumercrazy season, even if leading lady Myra DuBois described it as 'Just a panto. In a pub. On a roundabout.' She should be in marketing, that one.

# **Health Watch**

Hi Dr Alex I am 42 and my boyfriend is a 35 year old bodybuilder. I have a rather embarrassing problem. Since we started having unprotected sex (after testing negative for HIV) I always have sperm dripping out of my arse we have a lot of sex and he has a huge penis. Is this normal? Should I be worried? Steven

Hi Steven.

Thanks for writing in. Normally the rings of muscle of the anus (your anal sphincter) keep things tightly shut and in control of what comes out. The sphincter has in fact two rings of muscle which keep the anus closed: the inner (internal anal sphincter) ring, which keeps the anus closed at rest, and the outer (external anal sphincter) ring, which provides extra protection when the urge to open the bowel is felt and when we exert ourselves or cough or sneeze.

One possibility is that your sphincter is becoming a little loose. This is occasionally reported by guys who are into using big sex toys

or who enjoy fisting. It is not a problem with regular anal sex as the muscles goes back to normal after being stretched. However you say you partner has a huge penis so perhaps, if you have had a lot of anal sex, then over time the sphincter muscles have become damaged and looser.

If this is the case then it would be worth starting up some special exercises, called Kegel exercise or pelvic floor exercises, to strengthen the anal sphincter muscles. You can locate the muscles by trying to stop or slow down the flow of urine half way through a pee. Once you are confident you can feel where these muscles are, contract them for a slow count of five and then release for a

slow count of five. Repeat this cycle 10 times, three times a day. With time your sphincter muscles should become tighter.

However, you seem to suggest that your problem started after having unprotected sex with your partner. You also mention that you always have sperm dripping out of your arse. So, a definite possibility is that this is not sperm leaking out but that you have an infection. Gonorrhoea or chlamydia can cause a discharge from the arse, and so before you start worrying about having a loose arse you should go to a sexual health clinic for a full check-up.
