
Paul Can't Stop the Feeling!

HOMOPHOBIC

REPORTING

is still a thing

Dylan Jones looks at recent regressions in the way gay-related stories are being reported



T

here have been a few sensational stories involving gay men in the news this year. There was that whole Daniel May *First Dates* ridiculousness, which I think we'd all like to forget VERY quickly. In a similar vein was the scandal involving YouTuber Calum McSwiggan, which I'm sure HE'D like to forget very quickly.

Then a couple of months ago, there was the seemingly relentless coverage of the "married gay celebrity" who had a threesome, allegedly, in a paddling pool full of olive oil. It was made blindingly obvious who the celebrity in question was, but press laws prevented outlets from specifically naming him. "The unfaithful partner sought an injunction after learning a national newspaper in the UK intended to reveal details of his affair" the Daily Mail reported gleefully.

RIGHT, stop there. Firstly, assuming someone is "unfaithful" just because he sleeps with someone other than his partner, is a tediously unimaginative way of looking at things. They know nothing about the couple's relationship. It could be an open relationship – a loving arrangement where they sit and have dinner together, then go off and sleep with other people. In fact, they're both very cultured, artistic, eccentric people, so in all likelihood it IS

an open relationship. Which is perfectly fine.

It's typical of The Daily Mail, not exactly known for their sociopolitical diplomacy, to unblinkingly impose this heteronormative ideology (YES I WENT THERE) on our unnamed gay celebrity couple.

But quite apart from the usual old mainstream pigeonholing, we need to look at the way gay stories are reported. The headline of the Mirror was "GAY CELEBRITY WRITHED AROUND IN PADDLING POOL OF OIL WITH MARRIED MAN". The fact that he's gay shouldn't factor into this. It's a story about a celebrity threesome. The sexualities, or even genders of those involved doesn't need to be stated. So why did they add it? To make it more outrageous, more shocking and, to some people, more grotesque.

The fact that this story got reported at all, is testament to the homophobia that still exists in the press. Straight footballers probably have paddling pool olive threesomes on an almost weekly basis, but that doesn't get reported does it? And don't even get me started on what goes on in Chris Brown's poolhouse.

No, the aim of this story, pure and simple, was to paint gay men as selfish partiers who are incapable of living normal lives and looking after children. Much of the reporting emphasized the fact that the couple had children, stating that they posted pictures of their kids on social media frequently. Even mentioning this in

the same breath as the word “threesome”, dredges back up all those archaic preconceptions of gay men as sexual deviants, and the much darker, underlying implication was essentially “are these children safe with these perverts?”.

Which leads me nicely on to X-Men director Brian Singer. Back in 2014, a string of stories hit the press as reports came out of various “gay orgy parties” and an incident, according again to the Mail, where he “threw hundreds of dollars at a male stripper for lap dances.”

Again – if he’d been straight, and threw money at a female stripper, THIS WOULDN’T HAVE BEEN A STORY. I’m willing to bet that every straight film director in Hollywood has been to a strip club, given money to strippers, and probably done a bit of coke while they’re at it, but that hasn’t been splashed across the Daily Mail, has it? They paired the story with a report of model Michael Egan accusing Singer of sexually assaulting him when he was a teenager.

Now, I don’t deny that some of Brian Singer’s activities have been questionable. The countless quashed allegations of sexual assault. The pool parties with questionably aged boys. Most notably, the story of Shawn Ashmore, who plays Ice Man in the X-Men movies, and the reportedly unspeakably degrading things he did to get the role.

But again, even if all of this is true – it happens in the straight world all the time. It’s blindingly obvious that that sexual favouritism and grooming of young and underage actors and actresses happens in Hollywood constantly, and is an accepted fact of life within the industry. All you have to do to figure that out is read a Brett Easton Ellis novel or, actually, watch an episode of *Gossip Girl*.

More notable than all of this though, is the press’ attitude towards recent developments in the ongoing PrEP debate. The courts ruled last week that the NHS is allowed to provide PrEP to those who need it. The Daily Mail headed up the charge

following the decision, with the front page headline “WHAT A SKEWED SENSE OF VALUES”, while Channel 5’s *The Wright Stuff*, started their discussion with the question “Should the NHS blow £20m on an HIV drug for gay men who won’t use condoms?” The Mail went on to say it would be “fraught with dangers” as it is “not 100 per cent effective.” They failed to mention that, whilst not 100% effective, it is 99% effective. So pretty much just as effective as condoms.

This is beyond questionable use of gay stories for titillation. It’s out and out homophobia, in its most insidious, exploitative form. In a rhetoric that’s darkly similar to the way press treated gay men during the AIDs crisis, we’re being painted as irresponsible hedonists.

Whilst I, in fact, am an irresponsible hedonist, so they’d be right about me, most gay men actually aren’t. Most gay men are much the same as anyone else. They like to sit on a nice Ikea sofa, drink a nice crisp glass of wine, and watch *Strictly Come Dancing*. If we were ACTUALLY all off having bareback orgies at all hours of the day, we’d never get anything done. There’d be a lot less hair salons around, and pride events would never get organized.

What The Daily Mail has done is illegal. It’s illegal to use the press to incite hatred towards a minority group, and that’s exactly what their tone and headlines are doing. They’re doing their best to drag us kicking and screaming back into the twentieth century. Why? Because it’s their job. They’re doing it to women too, and to immigrants, and to pretty much anyone else who’s not white, straight and called Clive.

That doesn’t mean we should accept it. We got where we are today by fighting against exactly this type of discrimination. And it IS discrimination. They’re criticizing us for wanting access to a product we’re fundamentally entitled to. We’re being treated as second-class citizens, as less than people. That sounds dramatic, but it’s true. So let’s not put up with it! Talk about it, inform people. And for god’s sake, the next time you trip over the Mail on your parents’ doorstep, chuck it in the bin.

Every year I cover Maisie Trollette's birthday and every year my admiration for this great performer grows. David Raven (the man behind Maisie) has been treading the boards as a cabaret artist for fifty-five years; can you imagine being in the same job for fifty-five years? I mean, I worked in retail for just two years when I was a chicken and I wanted to claw my own face off every single morning, because I hated it so much.

Therein lies the key point though; David loves what he does. He always has and always will. You can hear and feel a passion for performing in his voice when you talk to him. Whether it's about the past, present or future, the excitement remains, and the enthusiasm is infectious.

Performers such as Maisie, Phil Starr, Adrella and others lived through the most testing times our community has ever faced. They paved the way, and Maisie remains the sole survivor of that

era, still up on the stage doing what comes naturally to him like a true pro. As he told me: "It's about having a persona and being a professional performer. That's so important. You're dressing up for the audience not yourself."

'I don't want to suck on the end of a dildo, OK?!' Jesus, lady, we get the message, but what would you do if your hot, spunky boyfriend suddenly wanted to swap his cock for a pussy? How would your dick – accustomed to shagging his butt – feel pumping his new, sopping, wet snatch? No wonder hardcore, anally retentive dyke Alice can't deal with her long-term girlfriend revealing she wants to be a man!

Sharp, touching and viciously funny, Rotterdam remixes the fearlessly queer attitude of Russell T Davies' Cucumber and Banana shows into way-overdue, gender-fluid farce. Who needs the sappy earnestness of Transamerica and other, earnestly plodding tripe? Me, I've been screaming out for frenzied, drug-fucked transsexual irreverence for years, for drama truly reflecting the way we live!

It's about time. Finally, with gender-neutral toilet issues convulsing even the most redneck states of the USA, and fully-transitioned barristers in the UK, transsexuality's a media sensation. But viewed more cynically, it's also lucrative as fuck – branding CEOs worldwide must be wanking themselves raw at vast, new, gender-blender marketing opportunities!

However, back to Rotterdam, arguably a nowhere, transient dump for nowhere, transient people. No wonder playwright Jon Britain's stuck early 20s, lesbian shipping agent Alice there – she's as emotionally constipated as Theresa May slamming mega-doses of Xanax! Still sexually closeted, she's timidly planning to out herself to her parents by email, when partner Fiona suddenly drops a bombshell – she's becoming a man!

Screw Bourgeois and Maurice – this unintentional double act, ultra-uptight Alice and breezy, accept-me, future-dick-included Fiona – are the Patsy and Edina of absolutely fabulous, gender variance! Not that they know it – they're both fantastically blind to each other's needs, Fiona completely swamped by the fierce, testosterone rush of her imminent masculinity!

Still, all transitions are as much steep learning curve as previous, blanket denial, and Rotterdam's a beautifully layered dissection of sexual ambiguity. Alice, played with stunningly icy, middle-class restraint by Alice McCarthy, thaws from pure disgust at Fiona's plans to grudging empathy. Not unassisted, though – a brief fling with hot office junior Lelani (Jessica Clark) opens her mind, heart and body with reluctant sex and drugs. But glib, blasé and arrogant, Lelani's hugely unappealing, assuming every female's born screaming, bloody and shit-smearing into the world aching for cunt, GHB and double-ended dildos!

Gee – ever heard of different strokes for less full-on folks, madam? Obviously not – arrogance never looks beyond its own asshole – but writer Jon Brittain springs multiple, sexual strokes with the virtuosity of a master-class, transsexual hooker.

Christ, Fiona even emotionally back-stabbed her own brother - blokey non-entity Josh (Ed Eales-White)- luring an eager, confused Alice from his clueless cock. 'When do we ever know who we're attracted to?' Alice asks Josh, who answers, 'Whoever we think about when we masturbate'.

That's the problem – Alice, heartbreakingly, tells Fiona, now called Adrian, 'I'm gay – I don't want to get used to you being him'. Why should she? Then – with appalling presumption – Fiona/Adrian tells Alice that of course, Alice has never been gay, because Fiona's always been an undiagnosed man!

Certainly, she convinces here – all confrontational, space-devouring body language, actress Anna Martine's Fiona prowls the stage with the raw, predatory fire of K.D. Lang. Ferociously concerned with passing as a guy, despising any possibility of being mis-gendered, she brilliantly embodies the manic, sexually dictatorial tunnel-vision of early transition.

And sadly, that's where Rotterdam sucks. Sure, Alice's fling with Lelani makes Fiona savagely question her transsexuality, but the final scene's Alice deciding to accept Fiona as Adrian. WTF? If I wanted dumb, binary-sex love, I'd watch Neighbours, but Rotterdam could have delivered so much more!



HOLDING THE MAN



The acclaimed Australian gay drama *Holding the Man* arrives on DVD/VOD in Britain this week, while still touring the country as part of POUTfest. QX's Jack Leger spoke with director **NEIL ARMFIELD** about putting the true story on the big screen...

QX: Tim Conigrave published his memoir about his love for John Caleo shortly before his death from Aids in 1995. Why did it take so long to reach the screen?

Neil Armfield: I knew Tim a little, we mixed in the same circles. He started acting around the same time I started directing. Another filmmaker held the movie rights and worked on it for years, but couldn't crack its form. Then the screen rights lapsed, so I got them!

What was so difficult about it?

It's the story of a relationship, so if there wasn't chemistry between those two actors there was no film. Ryan Corr (who plays Tim) had emerged very early, but it took months and months to find Craig Stott (who plays John). We had to hold our cast reading here in London, because everyone was spread out between Australia, Los Angeles and Europe.

Ryan and Craig play Tim and John from about 15 to 35, which can't have been easy. They must have become very close while filming!

Well, we were shooting the scene where they go to bed and get caught. They were well into the scene, and the bond between them had been growing. I was watching through a window, and I had to call out and ask Craig if he could try to stop getting an erection, because it was showing. And he called back, "Yeah, that would be like asking the sun to stop coming out!" They were so easy with each other. With the climactic emotional and physical scene where they have their last fuck, we showed it to Rufus Wainwright, and he loved it and wrote that beautiful song.

The story is reminiscent of Philadelphia, but this is a much more honest depiction of gay sexuality.

We wanted the sex to be funny and real. For example, sauna scenes in gay films are often dark and full of self-hatred, but Tim has a fabulous time in the sauna! Actually, the joy of sex begins in their school days, and when you go back to that joy after the Aids diagnosis, I think there's an interesting kind of complexity and beauty to it.

Did you put any of your own story in there?


Of course. There's a scene where Tim tells his mum, over the making of hors d'oeuvres, that he and John both have Aids. I sat there just speechless with tears. When I was 17 my oldest brother died, and that was the first time I told my mother that I was gay. There was so much in this film where I was drawing on my memory. And if you're sitting there watching, and it's working, you can't help but partly be in your own past.

Gareth Edwards' 2014 *Godzilla* remake however, is not your usual popstar-casting, cliché-spitting, jungle-humping fare. It's actually very visceral. It takes its time a bit. There's some real identifiable human drama, and some real gut-wrenching suspense. All these qualities are far too rare in action movies and, more specifically, monster movies of the 21st century. These days, monster movies just lumber up to you, regurgitate a steaming, meaningless pile of special effects on your head, then lumber off again.

Now, don't get me wrong, *Godzilla* IS special effects-laden. There is not one, not two, but THREE monsters, and they snap and screech and lurch their way through jungles, oceans and several major landmarks. But Edwards injects some unexpected imagination into it all. There are

some truly beautiful sequences, most notably a breathless plane-drop over San Francisco, and an inconceivably destructive scene in Hawaii.

You'll see what we mean when you watch it, but there are a lot of tiny little attentions to detail, meticulous usage of tools like light, colour and texture. The effect is magical, and at times quite terrifying.

It's understandable that some cinemagoers found the film disconcerting at the time of its release. It is NOT what it says on the tin. It's not so much a monster movie, as a drama, with monsters thrown in. It bears a striking resemblance to Gareth Edwards' egregiously overlooked 2010 masterwork, *Monsters*. The humans have the same introspective, shell-shocked look about them, and the creatures have the same flickeringly beautiful aesthetic. It also has a distinct whiff of the *Cloverfield* about it at times.

The cast holds up very well too. Elizabeth Olsen shines in one of her first serious roles as a woman torn between her child and her husband. Bryan Cranston, always brilliant, makes a wonderful mad professor figure. And Aaron Taylor-Johnson is sexy and current as a soldier who unwittingly stumbles into the role of the main protagonist.

Basically, if you like your action movies with a dash of intelligence, a lingering sense of beauty, and some half-decent acting, this one's for you! If not, go watch *Anaconda* starring Jennifer Lopez.






