


## BBC Seeking LGBT+ Archive Material for 50 Years Celebration

## 'Pride of Place' Campaign Wins Listed Status for LGBT+ Homes



Several significant LGBT+ properties have been listed by Historic England in a bid to commemorate queer history. Oscar Wilde's house at 34 Tite Street in Chelsea now has a blue plaque, as does composer Benjamin Britton's home in Suffolk. Other properties that have been included are the house shared by diarist Anne Lister, considered 'the first modern lesbian', and her partner in 1836, as well as a mansion in Surrey shared by a gay couple, which was designed with a master bedroom that could be separated in two for when prying visitors came round. **Tell us a bit about yourself. How did you get into what you're doing today?**


I first started buying proper Underground Music when I was 12, and played it for my friends' birthday parties. I became a professional vocalist at 14 and ran my first West End club night at 16, called WET. # Austin Armacost

American/British reality star Austin Armacost has had a surreal, breathtaking whirlwind of a life, from dating internationally renowned fashion designers, to spending a night at the Beckhams'.

Now he's using his glamorous platform to campaign for LGBT rights. He sat down with Dylan Jones and they talked partying, pantos and politics.

**Hi Austin. So you've done a lot of campaigning for gay rights. What first made you decide to use your platform for change?**

It was actually a very specific moment in time! We had finished filming season 2 of "The A List New York" and the entire cast was doing The Wendy Williams show. Wendy asked each of us what we were going to do now and one of the cast members Mike Ruiz replied "it's what we do now with our public profiles that will ultimately define our legacy in this community." That really struck a chord with me and from that point forward, I knew I had the responsibility to help make a change in this world. I immediately got hold of local, state, national, and international organizations fighting for gay rights, to find out what I could do to help. Also, as I got older and started realizing the inequities in our world, I couldn't sit idly by as our brothers and sisters in the LGBT community were being discriminated against, persecuted, and sometimes even killed.

**Do you think there's still a long way to go to fight for equal rights?**

When I'm asked this question I always have to answer it in two parts.

A) In America, yes we have full marriage equality in all fifty states. The problem now becomes convincing the crazy, conservative, religious fanatics that we're just normal people. We aren't all out having anonymous sex, or luring young boys, or using drugs constantly...most of the gay men and women I know are successful, happy, healthy people.

B) Yes, there is still a lot of work to do in parts of the world where being gay is still considered a major crime. Execution (although rarely used anymore) in some countries is still legal for the crime of homosexuality. But with the state of the world right now and what's happening to LGBT people in the Middle East and ISIS occupied parts of Syria...I tell gays and lesbians in this country to stop fucking whining! Equal rights will come but it's going to take time. People are being murdered and we're complaining about not having a specific bathroom, I find it all a bit out of perspective.

**You say you want to fight for acceptance for trans people.**

**What's inspired you to do this?**

I personally have a few friends who are trans but that's not the only reason I think it's important. They're one of the last minorities in the world to gain some sort of acceptance, and understanding. Trans people I feel for a very long time have been an underground, secret, taboo BUT are now coming to the forefront of the media with people like Caitlyn Jenner, Laverne Cox, Carmen Carrera, etc. Before we can demand equal rights from outside our community, we need equal rights and acceptance within our own community. I still many times see trans people discriminated against by gays, lesbians, and bisexuals... WHY? They've been through the same struggle we have and you're just perpetuating intolerance. It's time we stood TOGETHER!

**I'm sure you've had a lot of cool celebrity encounters. What's been your best one?**

My best would have to be the night I spent at David & Victoria Beckham's house. Marc Jacobs was a great friend at the time and Victoria had just shot the ad campaign for his clothing line. David and the family had also just moved to Los Angeles as he signed with football team LA Galaxy. It was a very private dinner with only the four of us (plus Marc's trainer) at their home. She was lovely, smiley, giggly, witty, and just a pleasure to be around. David was...well, he's a good looking lad. The image and persona of Victoria being a complete bitch is totally false!

**Do you have any idols who've influenced how you behave in the limelight?**

I wouldn't say one person in particular has helped shape my behaviour, but my agent has a lot to do with my public image. Although when I was in the CBB house, it was 100% Austin. Afterwards we had a strategy of which projects I would take on and which ones I wouldn't. I think I have a pretty good public image in the UK and have a lot more fans than haters. I'm a very open and honest person, especially in public and in interviews

so people get to see the real me. Opening up about my brother and my mom on CBB was a difficult thing to talk about, but extremely cathartic and necessary for my sanity to get through that show.

**So you have a lot of experience of both American, and British culture. What do you think the main differences are?**

The main difference between Americans and Brits would have to be the level of patience that British people have in comparison to Americans. Americans are very fast to jump up into an argument, escalate a situation, etc. Brits are a bit more calm and relaxed. Also Americans just LOVE to ask questions. Any chance they get, or any information point they see, they want to ask at least a dozen questions. If I'm at Manchester airport flying home and I hear an American, I walk the other direction. Even though I am one, I am not a big fan of Americans. I have been here for almost seven years so I think I can say that.

**Do you prefer living here to America?**

A hundred per cent! Now that my husband and I have split up I see myself spending a lot more time here. Even though he is British, he much prefers the US. So at the moment, I am living in our British home, and he is living in our US home. Flip Flop!

**What do you think of the politics over there at the moment?**

It's nerve-racking to think a billionaire reality TV star could become our next president. I think that Hillary (while hardened and entrenched in politics) is by far the most qualified person to ever run for office. To not only see the first black president take office in 2009, but now potentially the first female president to take office in 2017. I love watching history being made.

**Some people find sudden fame quite difficult. How do you think you've dealt with it?**

My "fame" was in no way sudden. In this country yes I went into the house nobody knowing who I was and came out with a lot of people knowing my name. But I have been around this (celebrity) game for a while. First with Marc, then with "The A List NY," etc. I have friends and family that keep me extremely grounded. I try to lead as normal a life as possible while I'm not "working." I do my own laundry, cook my own food, bloody hell I still take the bus actually! I don't know how to drive in this country.

**What do you do to chill out?**

There are several things I do to chill out. Exercise is a massive part of my life, not only for my job but also to lose yourself in the gym for ninety minutes, and just escape is a great feeling. I also really enjoy nature; hiking, rock climbing, kayaking...nature calms me down.

**And what would be your ideal partying night?**

I'm not much of a partier if I am honest (anymore). I'm almost, thirty so those days have come and gone. I used to be at circuit parties every weekend, "partying," and just being a mess...I've grown out of that stage a bit. I don't do drugs anymore, but can still go out on the lash every now and then. I actually prefer a good day session. Pub crawl around my local village or a boozy brunch in London!

**Finally, what are you up to for the rest of this year? Do you have any exciting projects in the pipeline?**

Well, I'm confirmed for PANTO in Rochdale this year with Russell Grant & Chelsea Healey. I'll once again be playing Prince Charming with Chelsea as Snow White and Russell playing the evil queen. My 2017 calendar will soon be available for autographed pre-order. I've just signed with a TV/Film agency in Manchester called Nemesis, because long before reality TV I was a trained actor. So, hoping to get more back into scripted television rather than reality. I am currently the face of PROWLER and have several campaigns coming out for them including VERSACE, DSquared2, and DIESEL. As well as the new face of jewelry line called Terry Terry. So yes, quite busy at the moment! But I love work. I'm also finding a little bit of time to date as well. I don't like being single, so am enjoying getting back out there and finding a good man.

# Hey Girls, Hey Boys, Super-strain VD, Here We Go!

You may have seen stories pop up in the news every couple of months or so warning of a 'super-strain' of gonorrhoea that has become resistant to the treatments available. So, is this typical tabloid sensationalism, or is there genuine cause for concern?

Joe Holyoake speaks to Dr Gwenda Hughes, head of STI surveillance at Public Health England, to shed light on it.

## **What is meant when these news stories talk of a 'super-strain' of gonorrhoea?**

Well, first of all, we tend to shy away from calling it 'super-gonorrhoea' as it's not quite accurate. In England, we treat gonorrhoea with a dual system of drugs – ceftriaxone and azithromycin. Currently, there have been strains recorded which are highly resistant to azithromycin. This is a concern for us if it spreads more widely, as it may gain resistance to ceftriaxone as well. If that happens, then we will probably see treatment failures, as none of the current drugs will work.

However, it's important to highlight that we have only ever had one case where the strain was resistant to both drugs, but it was eventually treated successfully, though with some difficulty, I must add.

## **Will there be any new antibiotics to treat it?**

We are aware of some drugs that are currently in development that may be able to treat it, but nothing in the immediate future.

## **Will we see other STIs gain a resistance to anti-biotics?**

Yes, it can happen and we have seen that other STIs, such as syphilis, can become resistant to certain anti-biotics, though most of these STIs can still be effectively treated with other antibiotics. We also know that many other infections, not just STIs, gain a resistance to antibiotics, so much so that the World Health Organisation has made tackling antibiotic resistance one of their main priorities.

However, the reason we're particularly worried about gonorrhoea is because it has a long history of developing resistance rapidly and we're using the last line of drugs to treat it.

## **How many cases of the high-level resistant strain of gonorrhoea have there been so far?**

As of August 2016, there have been a total of 48 confirmed and a further 2 probable cases. Though it was initially recorded in

northern England, we are seeing a wider regional spread now, included cases in London and the South East. There have been heterosexual cases recorded and increasing numbers among men who have sex with men.

## **Is it an international problem, or one consigned to the UK at the moment?**

In the UK, we have identified an outbreak of high-level azithromycin resistant strains, but cases have been reported in other countries. We're recording more cases than other countries, but that may be because it hasn't been picked up or recorded in other countries. Recently we have heard from our colleagues at the Centre of Disease Control in the United States that they are currently managing an outbreak of high-level azithromycin resistant gonorrhoea in Hawaii.

## **Are there extra precautions people should be taking?**

Well, nothing aside from the advice we already give to avoid gonorrhoea and any other STI for that matter, which is to wear condoms if you're having sex with a new partner or casual partners. We don't want to cause undue alarm at this stage, as all of the high-level resistant strains have been treated successfully. However, there is the possibility that we may not have effective treatment for gonorrhoea in future, so we want to emphasise that prevention will be easier than the cure.

## **And what's your opinion on the media coverage this has received so far?**

Well, the media have a particular slant on it! However, we do welcome the coverage, as it is an important public health concern and we do want to raise awareness. We would like people to be aware that it may not be so easily treatable in the future, so they can protect themselves by using condoms and avoiding infection, as in future it may not be as easily treatable as it currently is.




They lived through the reign of Thatcher, a strong, deeply



# Royal Vauxhall

T

here’s the old adage that comedy is just tragedy plus time, and Royal Vauxhall gauges that time at around 28 years. It’s 1988 and the three lead protagonists all have deep-rooted problems: one has a tepid marriage

into a family that never really accepted her; another is suing his ex-wife for revealing his homosexuality in a tell-all book; and the other is dying slowly of a disease that no-one really knows anything about. Princess Diana, Kenny Everett and Freddie Mercury are three of the most famous and adored faces in the country, but behind their cheery façade, they are all truly miserable. The opening song has them gloating ‘what would you do to be us?’, but by the end, we conclude that it’s not much.

Yet despite this morose set-up, Desmond O’Connor’s musical is full of laughs, mostly abetted by the glorious benefit of hindsight. The best jokes of the night come at the expense of Diana’s cold and distant husband, with her cutting response when offered a line of coke the pick of the bunch. The songs are mostly bouncy bastardisations of Queen songs and other 80s pop classics, so it’s great to be able to focus on the wit of the lyrics, without the pitfall of forgettable melodies that taint so many low-budget musicals.

Royal Vauxhall sees these three larger-than-life characters shackled up in a Kensington flat, when they decide to cure their boredom by dragging themselves up and heading to the Royal Vauxhall Tavern. We’ve all been there, but the big difference is we don’t risk jeopardising our public profile every time we saunter up Kennington Lane. Well, most of us don’t at least. The musical follows their night, but the daily pressures of maintaining their immaculate public profiles catches up with the trio and their vulnerabilities spill over, conveniently into song.

Despite playing such familiar faces, the cast are able to play their tortured characters convincingly. Sarah-Louise Young is just the right combination of flirty and kittenish as Diana, while Tom Giles’ does what Adam Lambert and many others have failed to do in capturing at least a modicum of Freddie’s showmanship and raw sex appeal. The best is Matthew Jones who is perfect at capturing the gurning and eager to please Kenny Everett, who never lets an innuendo go by unprobed, but is perhaps the most vulnerable and closeted of them all. There’s a superb raft of secondary characters, such as the lyrical bouncer to the RVT, a curt drag queen, and, as no play set in the 1980’s would be complete without it, a cameo from Margaret Thatcher.

The musical has just come back from

a successful run at the Edinburgh Fringe Festival, but it’s difficult to imagine seeing it anywhere other than the eponymous venue. The cast are constantly jumping off stage and mixing with the crowd, lending it an air of chummy intimacy. Much like the RVT itself, the production is a little rough around the edges, but it more than compensates with playful charm, especially when a minor technical issue is played off with some exemplary time-wasting (‘Tell me again, Freddie, how you wrote Bohemian Rhapsody’). Overall, it’s well balanced, on the surface a camp romp, but one unafraid to explore the internal strife at the heart of each character. Royal Vauxhall plays again on several dates throughout the autumn and anyone already smitten with the venue will adore this loving tribute.

# BRIDGET JONES'S BABY

**H**opes were not high for *Bridget Jones's Baby*. A development plagued by delays and complications, the exit of Hugh Grant as the iconically sexy Daniel Cleaver, an increasingly impatient and implanted Renée Zellweger, all culminating in a bizarre September release date – not quite summer blockbuster, and not even close to Bridget's usual reindeer jumper Christmas slot. Not to mention the fact that it followed in the footsteps of the critically panned *Edge Of Reason*, an indulgent, bloated, frilly mess of a sequel.

It comes as a bit of a surprise, then, that *Bridget Jones's Baby* is close to perfect. Not 100% perfect. No film is 100% perfect. But it's close. In fact, when films are as well made as this one, it's hard to put your finger on why. Interestingly, a big factor in its success was probably British acting legend and queen of enunciation, Emma Thompson. She joined proceedings at a late stage, both as a character - Bridget's hilariously cynical antenatal doctor - and as an assistant scriptwriter. It's brilliant to imagine Emma sweeping onto set, handing a distressed Renée a piping hot espresso, clapping her hands together and saying "RIGHT, let's get this sorted!"

And get it sorted she did! Her trademark glint-eyed sense of irony really shows, and on top of that, the script is truly modern, original and funny. It couldn't be more 2016. In fact it's slightly 2017, with well-educated, non-patronising explorations of everything from polyamorous relationships to the treatment of pregnant women in the workplace. So many film franchise instalments have tried to keep up with the times lately, but they've done it clumsily, by shoving iPads into the hands of confused protagonists, or worse, making awfully misguided transgender jokes (we're looking at you, *Ab Fab*). *Bridget Jones's Baby* DOES make reference to millennial knit-your-own-clichés like

Instagram, kale smoothies and man-buns, but it does so with a knowing, self-conscious wink.

It's also refreshingly feminist. The feminist credentials of Bridget Jones, both as an individual and as a cultural phenomenon, have always been up for debate. In the past two movies she's had some strong qualities, but ultimately, has been rather helpless and fallen into the waiting arms of a man. This is different. Granted, she still wants a man. And that's fine! It's ok to want a man! But she's far more assertive, she makes her own decisions, and does exactly what she wants on her own terms, much to the confusion and anger of Colin Firth and Patrick Dempsey, who are often literally stumbling after her in the wake of positive pregnancy tests, drunken festival shags, funereal faux-pas and cringe-worthy christenings.

It does well on the slapstick front too. It wouldn't be a Bridget Jones movie without a bit of slapstick, but slapstick is hard to do well; everything's been done before, and at the end of the day, there are only so many times that someone falling over can be funny. But they pull it off! We won't ruin it for you, but there's a particular scene involving a revolving door, which is so outrageous and original, you can't help but laugh.

The next box this movie ticks is acting. Renée Zellweger, looking slightly unrecognisable but nevertheless sensational, delivers possibly her best turn yet as Bridget. It's mindblowing when you remember...SHE'S NOT BRITISH! She's from Texas! Anyway, it's a very rare and special performance when someone gets so totally involved in their character. Other iconic examples that spring to mind are Jonny Depp as Jack Sparrow, and PERHAPS Sarah Jessica Parker as Carrie Bradshaw (although she was essentially just playing herself, so that might not count).

It also has wonderful turns from all the other characters, old and new. Bridget's friends

are always a joy, especially the swearsy Sally Phillips as Shaz. There's a great new character in Bridget's younger newsreader colleague Miranda, played with luminous, hair-tossing confidence by the relatively unknown Sarah Solemani. Patrick Dempsey is appealing, sexy and realistic as new love interest Jack. And of course the old guard; brilliant Gemma Jones and Jim Broadbent as Bridget's well-meaning but hopeless parents; Colin Firth, the epitome of stiff-upper lip; and good old Celia Imrie, who seems unable let a British romcom pass her by without diving in to deliver some sass!

Special mention goes to Kate O'Flynn, who plays Bridget's ball-busting hipster new manager. With blood-red lipstick, jangling bracelets, a straight fringe and an unblinkingly modern and cynical take on media, she's a dead ringer for one of our faves, editor-at-large of *Attitude*, Paris Lees! In fact, the character is SO like Paris, even down to the accent and mannerisms, that it's uncanny. There's a distinct possibility she may actually be based on Paris. We'll see what Paris thinks. Let us know when you see it babes.

But the best thing about *Bridget Jones's Baby* is that it takes risks. Risks it didn't need to take. They could have churned out two hours of fluff, slapped *Respect* by Aretha Franklin on the soundtrack, got critically panned, and made a good few million. Instead, they actually used imagination and intelligence to make a credible, rewarding piece of cinema. It is possibly the first mainstream movie in 2016 to do this. Interestingly, America weren't ready for it. Its box office figures across the pond aren't just disappointing, they're terrible. But here, it's paid off. People love it and it's broken box office records. Good old Brits, we know great comedy when we see it! And *Bridget Jones's Baby* truly is a great comedy. Come the fuck on Bridget!







# DIVERSITY ROLE MODELS


The anti-bullying charity Diversity Role Models (DRM) recently moved into an office at St Anne's Church on Dean Street. This weekend sees Soho's Ku group venues mark their arrival with events to promote the charity – and, of course, raise some funds.

Suran Dickson, DRM Chief Executive, said: "I founded DRM in 2011 to respond to the homophobic, biphobic and transphobic bullying which young people face every day in UK schools. DRM stops such bullying before it happens by educating young people about differences in sexuality and gender identity, and empowering school staff to tackle bullying behaviour when they see it.

In their workshops, young people get to hear how being LGBT has affected volunteer role models or those close to them, and ask often thoughtful and thought-provoking questions. They get a wider perspective on what it means to be LGBT. By challenging negative stereotypes and the misuse of language, DRM supports LGBT youth and creates LGBT allies of the future among their peers.

They've teamed up with Ku, because it'll be a great partnership to help them find new donors, and new volunteers to go into schools, and help make them a safer environment for all young people, LGBT or otherwise.


