Is Gay Marriage making us the Same or Tame?

With same-sex marriage having become legal in England and Wales last weekend, QX spoke to gay men across London about their experiences of the bill being passed. Is this moment one of the greatest triumphs for the gay community? Or is it simply an empty appeasement? And what does marriage mean to you personally? Alongside one of the happy couples who got married at the weekend, a cross-section of gay London gives its opinions...



Clinical psychologist Doc Monaco, 46, and his partner Aaron Erhab, 23, a PhD student at UCL, were among the first same-sex couples to get married last weekend. Here, Doc speaks to QX about marriage...

Why did you decide to get married on the weekend of the law passing?

For me, I'm a bit older than my partner, so I didn't think getting married was ever going to be an option in my lifetime – to actually be regular, 'full' married. And for my partner, who's a bit younger, he had just come out over the past year and a half of our relationship, so for him it was like reclaiming his identity in the community. So we were very excited, but for different reasons, I think.

And what does marriage mean to you?

It means a lot to me, both because it's having the same rights and the full rights as everyone else, but for me, I think, it also means for everyone who comes after now, more of an acceptance in society. We're just like everyone else. We should have the same rights as everyone else and it's okay to be gay.

You see it as a greater integration?

I don't know if 'integration' is the right word, perhaps 'normalisation', so that there won't be any more bullying and people won't have to be ashamed of being gay.

Do you see this law as a huge step forward for the gay community in general, then?

Absolutely. Not only just to get the rights of marriage but also to get more acceptance in the world, really.

Equality vs Assimilation

Cliff Joannou on why he wore the wedding dress but might not be getting married...

So, we can all go and get married now! I'm so happy. I'm over the moon.

I can't wait to finally pick out that wedding dress and send out those invites and go to Harvey Nicholls and post a gift list online. Not.

You see, I've already worn that wedding dress. Several times.

Once upon a time, in a land far, far away (South London in the early Noughties) I had a bit of reputation of turning up at fancy dress events in *that* wedding dress. The first time was at White Party at The Fridge (now the Electric Brixton) where I descended out of the DJ booth into a sea of muscle boys in the flowing white gown I bought earlier that afternoon from the local Oxfam charity shop. (£25 reduced from £35 because the Sales Assistant found it rather amusing watching me try it on, and because she figured I'd only wear it once... more fool her.)

The second time it made an appearance was at Pushca's New Year's Eve party. It then came back from the dead for Halloween at Heaven followed immediately by a run around Trade at Turnmills.

There it was, once more, at my 30th birthday where I gave a surprise 'performance' to Shirley Bassey's 'This Is My Life' as Whatever Happened to Baby Jane was screened in the background in front of a gathered crowd of friends and family, including my Greek Cypriot mother. (Her reaction: "But where is the groom?")

Oh, and there was the wedding dress again at Horse Meat Disco's Vogue Ball.

That frock was £25 well spent, trust me. And let me tell you something, wedding dresses can survive a spin the washing machine at 40 degrees.

What people didn't realise was that while I was making a total tit of myself at all these occasions in a cheap as chips wedding dress is that this was not just my seeking attention. It was actually a small, somewhat almost imperceptible, political statement on my behalf. You see I grew up in a Greek Orthodox family with some thirteen uncles and aunties, all of which had on average three or four children that by freak of nature were mostly female. That's more family weddings one should ever have to attend in one lifetime, and a lot of wedding dresses that I watched walk down an aisle. At every occasion an aunt would ask me, "So, when are you going to get married?"

As a repressed teenage boy from Croydon does, I locked the comments away in the back of my huge closet of a mind.

In truth, the answer at the time was, of course: "Well, never. Because your religion thinks I am dirt, while the law doesn't recognise my relationships as having the validity to be on par with yours." Donning that wedding dress, in a gay club, on stage, at all times inebriated, was a big 'Fuck You' to a culture that dictated that there was just one purpose in life: to meet a woman and get married.

I grew up in a society when gay relationships were second to heterosexual ones, so subconsciously I never took the concept of 'marriage' very seriously. And I am certainly not alone. I'm sure that many others who grew up in frequently homophobic cultures, be they religious or not, from Muslim to Irish, via the Black community or Greek, have experienced the same emotions of a love that is judged of lesser value.

I have no doubt that a considerable portion of the negative identity and confidence issues that sometimes blight the LGBT community today, from alcohol and drug abuse, to self-worth and suicide, have their roots in growing up in a society that doesn't understand gay relationships and shames our sexual desires.

But what *equal* marriage has done is state, in the eyes of the law, homosexual love is now *equal* to heterosexual love. Already the Archbishop of Canterbury has signalled that the Church's resistance to same sex marriage is over. Even the Pope commented about gay lifestyles, "Who am I to judge?"

The fact is that the decree of law *does* change minds. It's just a shame that it takes a legal battle to show religious people the validity of love.

But what does gay marriage really mean for our community?

What it should remind us is that *equality* should not mean *assimilation*. Simply because we can do something, it doesn't mean that we should. I would like to think that we as a gay community can continue to forge our own unique identity. Let

us not simply take on the shackles that have defined heterosexual relationships, sometimes to their detriment, sometimes not, for hundreds of years.

I hope we don't start becoming embarrassed of expressing ourselves as sexual beings. And I hope that we don't start apologising for why LGBT people often embrace sexuality in different ways. I think we have something to teach the wider community about breaking down repressive attitudes to love and sexuality, even as we sign into law for gay people a form of mainstream tradition that dictates many heterosexual lives.


I also hope that we don't start to pressure ourselves that we can only be happy as a gay or lesbian or bisexual or transgender person if we are settled down with somebody 'nice', married and start adopting children. We did not fight for gay marriage so we can all *aspire* to gay marriage. We fought for it to make us *equal*. To give us *choice*, where there was once *no choice*.

One of the wonders of the LGBT community is that for thousands of years we have redefined the boundaries of independence, sexuality, gender, identity and love. Let's not lose sight of that. Create your own life, because now – legally at least – there is nothing stopping you.

Westminster Council has been the subject of various informal complaints from gay Soho businesses on social media in recent years, regarding their enforcement of bureaucracy that has been described as bordering on harassment. However, the council would argue it has a duty and remit to protect its residents from excess noise and late night disruption. But, as Chris Amos of Manbar launches a 'Save Manbar' campaign to contest what he describes as Westminster's 'unfair' and 'draconian' actions against his venue, he questions whether the Council has an underlying motive to its moves. QX investigates further.

"WE REACHED OUT to Westminster City Council ourselves," says Chris Amos, owner of Manbar, describing when he first took over the formerly troubled venue at 79 Charing Cross Road. "We found the person in charge of the police and the Premises Licensing Inspector, and met up with them. We assured them we were going to do whatever it takes to work with the licensing objectives. We spent over £15,000 on a sound system that meant the venue was enveloped in sound at lower levels instead of being particularly loud, and we bought a new, improved sound limiter.

"But we had two noise complaints very close to each other from a tenant who lives two floors above Manbar when the new system was installed. This resulted in Westminster taking us to a tribunal to defend ourselves against the noise complaints. Since then they have been like a dog with a bone refusing to let go of an opportunity to close down another gay venue. We enlisted a sound acoustic

specialist and he made recommendations, which we took on board. Now, however, Westminster are refusing to agree the job is done and neither is the resident. I have even been in the flat; the Westminster City Council officer was in there one time doing a reading and has to ask his counterpart downstairs 'is the music on?' They had to switch off the fridge to hear it."

In the interests of producing the fairest and most accurate article possible here, it has to be stated that Ben Scotchbrook of Westminster Council's press office was unfailingly polite and helpful in putting together answers to our questions regarding this feature – a grace that QX has found palpably lacking in certain other London councils. Regarding the current Manbar case, we were given the official statement by Andrew Ralph, Noise & Licensing Manager, as: "It is certainly true that, after measures had been taken to limit noise at Manbar, our officers tested levels and found them to be acceptable. However, after we were

contacted again, our officers returned to find that the noise levels were far higher and amounted to a statutory nuisance. That is not acceptable."

This sounds fair enough. Yet Amos has directed us to a particular of this case that Patrick Bangura, Environmental Health Officer, clearly states, when investigating the noise levels above Manbar on Tuesday 25th February, that he 'knocked on [a flat] which was underneath the complainant's flat and saw two men watching TV and not playing music.' However, when Amos independently contacted the residents living in this flat underneath the complainant, one of them attested in a signed witness statement that both men were asleep at the time and 'were woken by constant knocking at our front door.' When I asked Westminster Council about this discrepancy, they replied that, "Any visits by our Noise Team are likely to be presented as evidence in this week's hearings so it wouldn't be appropriate to comment at this stage."

Perhaps it seems like a niggling detail, but if the Council have misrepresented facts in their official statement then it justifiably throws into quandary how far their official line can be trusted. Westminster Council indeed have a duty to protect and uphold complaints from their tenants. However, it is also conceivably important for all those who enjoy and love Soho, to ensure that its soul is not knocked out of it for the wrong reasons.




Dive in...



Chris Mears is one of the UK's most accomplished diving champions. He's also known as Tom Daley's pal. After an ankle injury in 2013 put him out of training for a period, he turned his attention to music and started fiddling with knobs in the production studio. Next Monday, he DJs an exclusive set at **Popcorn @ Heaven** in support of the Elton John AIDS Foundation. Cliff Joannou met him on a sunny Saturday afternoon for a coffee where he was disappointingly not wearing Speedos. He clearly didn't get the memo...

You're just recovering from a major injury...

At the end of last year, I rolled both my ankles, so as well as being sore it put me out for so long. It's horrible. Really bad. I was just training, doing a jump, and I wasn't even doing anything that spectacular. It's that frustrating, and then you're out for three months. This was a tough one, because I was making the move from training in Southampton to Leeds, so I was battling with that, let alone switching coaches and being on crutches.

Does diving feel like 'work' when you're training?

It is my job, but it is the best job in the world. I like putting myself out of my comfort zone and getting that buzz, and that's what diving gives me pretty much every day. What most people see is all the spins, twists, turns, entry, but it's so much more than that. Like, there's so many basics you have to do, and doing thousands of them every day can be quite repetitive. But training is about 60% gym to get your body fit.

Really silly question, but how do sportspersons like yourself earn a living?

It's Lottery funded by UK Sport, which is awesome. So we get a salary, if you like. Depending on results in the year, we have to hit our targets that are given by our Performance Director to earn our funding back. You can relate it to if you have a job you have to meet your targets otherwise you're not pulling your weight.

London 2012 was the first Olympics in which social media was so proliferated. Is it hard to stay focused on training now that sports people also have to maintain a 'celebrity' persona?

I think it's better because it shows you that if you train well, and you perform well, you get more of a reward for it. Although you end

up getting a lot of attention, and sometimes I guess you could say it could be unwanted, but in most cases it's good. Now, if you hit that target that you've always dreamed of doing, you get recognition for it.

What are your next big events?

This year I've got London World Series coming up in April, then the Commonwealth Games, maybe one or two Grand Prix, World Championships and Europeans. It's a massive one!

Is that normal?

No, I did it last year, and I struggled, but I got through it.

Why struggled?

Mentally or physically? Physically. Because you have no time to train. I was doing so many competitions I had no time to lift heavy weights and get my bodyweight at the right level.

You probably spend more time nearly naked than most people.

Yeah. I've been doing what I do since I was seven and it's just what we have to do!

Do people assume you're gay because of the Gay Times shoot and having certain training buddies? [i.e. one Tom Daley]

I guess some people may think that, but if you dig around enough you know I've had a long-term girlfriend, but I've got a good gay fanbase and I love them all to bits.

You've started producing music.

I started when I was sixteen because I got glandular fever and was taken to hospital and

I had 5% chance of survival. Basically I nearly died... I got resuscitated six times. I had a lot of time out to recover and I didn't know what to do. I'd always played guitar and my cousin was a producer for pop artists and I started working on some stuff with him and learned the ropes and started making my own stuff. Things will be coming soon!

What DJs and producers do you look up to?


Tiesto, Hardwell, Avicii. I'd love to work with Zedd or Foxes.

You're playing at Popcorn at Heaven next. Is this your first club gig?

I've done other stuff before. I've supported Labrinth, Pendulum. But it's hard to keep doing it and to balance it, but I do it when I can and this one fitted in perfectly for me.

Is it hard to focus on the diving when you've got that in the back of your own mind?

Not at all really, because I've got my own studio kitted out and I think you need something else. Instead of watching TV to chill, I do this.

WHEN I SAW the advert a couple of weeks ago I was amazed... Has it really been 18 years since the Hoist flung its doors open to welcome the perverted and debauched of London? Wow, just wow. As a long-term regular at the venue I have been to most of the nights they run and the thing that stands out is the friendliness of the crowd. As a newbie to fetish it can be pretty daunting to slip in to your first latex shorts and stand there practically butt-naked with a load of strangers, but after a couple of visits watching the action it never takes long before those first faltering steps in to the darker corners are taken.

When the Hoist first opened it was the only south London dress code venue that allowed sex on the premises, and with others around town like the Block closing their doors it was a risky venture. But happily 18 years on it is home to a thriving community of leather and latex lovers with events for skinheads, guys in to sports gear and much more. There are the monthly SM Gays discovery nights for those new to it all and even a RoB shop on the premises to purchase both last minute essentials as well as complete new outfits.

I popped along for Fetish Friday of the birthday weekend which was celebrating the launch of the 'Age Of Consent' documentary to find a stage groaning under the weight of hot guys sucking cock - always a good start to a night. 



Celebrating our sex with pride, we chatted to two well-known boys from the world of gay porn, **Ashley Ryder** and **Kayden Gray**, to talk about what their ass means to them.



ASHLEY RYDER

What does your ass mean to you?

My ass means to me... everything really, I guess. It's the thing that comes after my personality. It's my personality then my ass. I'll make you laugh and then I'll sit on you.

And how did you discover you were a bottom?



GIVING GOOD ANAL

Anal sex is not the be all and end all of gay sex. Studies into the sex habits of gay men found that 7 in 10 say they had anal sex in the last year, meaning that 3 in 10 did not. That's compared to practically all sexually active gay men saying they had oral.

Some enjoy anal sex because of the thrill of being dominated. But for most it's the physical experience that provides the enjoyment as the prostate gland, a few inches inside the anus, gets massaged during anal sex. The gland is packed full of nerve fibres and so when stimulated can give you a deep sense of pleasure.

All gay men should know how to find a prostate gland! Insert your finger a few centimetres inside the anus and then toward the belly button. You should feel a smooth rubbery swelling. You will know you have found it if you give it a rub and get a feeling of pleasure. It can be hard to find your own, so if you can't, try to find someone else's!

First timers...

If you are new to anal sex then start by experimenting alone, using a dildo (a small one to start with!) and plenty of lube. Slowly insert your dildo just inside your anus. You may then feel some resistance as it comes up against an anal sphincter. This circular band of muscle is what controls your bowels movements. You can't force this muscle to relax and forcing through will only cause cramping and severe pain. Give it time – up to 30 seconds - and it will relax. Once it does you are safe to push further inside with ease. With time and practice you'll soon get the hang of how to pleasure yourself and then be pleased by the real thing.

If you find it hard to relax enough to be fucked then you could try amyl nitrate or poppers. These relax the sphincter muscles. Used in excess, they can cause a throbbing headache and should never be used if you take Viagra-type meds, so use them carefully and sparingly.

TIPS FOR TOPS

Give your partner time to relax. Barging into his arse is never a good idea, no matter how horny you are.

Work him up with your tongue first. Some guys might also enjoy you fingering them, but take care of sharp nails and be gentle!

Try to stimulate the prostate gland by angling your cock.

Vary the depth and rhythm, try circular movements and of course there are almost endless positions to try.

TIPS FOR BOTTOMS

Breathe in when you're penetrated and push down slightly as if you are opening your bowels as this can help your anal sphincter relax.

Don't wank as you are first penetrated as this tenses your anal sphincter – not what you want!

Give your top feedback so he knows when he's hitting the mark. Grimacing is never a hot look, so if it's not pleasurable then let him know so you can change positions.

ASS ISSUES

Most problems related to your butt can affect any man – gay or straight - because they are not caused by anal sex. So if you see your doctor you won't be outing yourself. Here are four common butt problems you should be aware of.

Bleeding

The most likely cause is nothing more serious than piles. These are swellings of the delicate veins inside the anus. The most common cause is constipation and therefore straining when you open your bowels, but they are also linked to weightlifting and being overweight. These all cause the veins to stretch and swell. Bleeding happens as a hard stool scratches them or being bashed during anal sex. The best treatment is with over the counter haemorrhoid creams that soothe and shrink piles. Also, keep your faeces soft by eating lots of fruit and vegetables and staying hydrated. If bleeding is ongoing or you develop a painful lump then see your GP.

Prostatitis

A couple of inches inside your butt and toward your belly button is the smooth walnut sized prostate gland. It's your GP spot. But it can also become swollen and inflamed, most often from a sexually transmitted infection. Common symptoms are an ache behind your balls, passing urine more often, a discharge from your penis and possible a fever. If you have these symptoms then you should see your GP or go to a sexual health clinic right away. Treatment is needed with antibiotics often for a few weeks.

Perforation

Thankfully very rare, but potentially fatal this is where something tears or punctures the wall of the rectum. That something is usually a fist or a toy. Usually, you would feel a sudden pain but not if the tear is small or your pain threshold has been affected by alcohol or drugs. If you suspect this may have happened go to A+E right away.

Itchy butt hole

This is a surprisingly common problem. Most often it is caused by allergy or sensitivity to a soap or shower gel. Remember, the skin around the butt hole is sensitive and should not be over washed. Also, substances in your faeces such as spices, coffee or alcohol can make the skin around your hole red, cracked and itchy. Common skin conditions such as eczema and psoriasis can affect the area and an itchy hole can also be from an STI or threadworms. To find out the cause it's best to see your GP for a check. It is rarely anything serious.

Sexually Transmitted Infections

Most, if not all STIs can affect your butt including gonorrhoea, chlamydia, syphilis, herpes and anal warts. If you experience pain when you open your bowels, get a discharge or feel a sore, ulcer or lump around your butt hole then it's time for a sexual health check-up!
